



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Stanley Esary Routine exam - noted crepitus in left stifle, O' reports this leg is stiff and he does limp on it intermittently.
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Left stifle crepitus, mild cranial drawer when knee is flexed.

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE STIFLE JOINTS

Canine Radiographs of both stifle joints in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Golden Retriever Both stifle joints have smooth osseous margins and present without evidence of intracapsular soft tissue swelling.
