Billy Mazlo Patient has been limping on left front leg for about 2 months now, sent first radiograph for consult with sonopath 2 months ago - was dx with prominent distal growth plate left ulna - this is recheck rad. O stated that when on Carprofen patient does not limp but as soon as he comes off of it he starts again.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LEFT CARPAL JOINT

Radiographs of the left carpal joint in a dorsopalmar view are provided for review.

BREED

Dachshund

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The distal growths plates of the left ulna and radius are nearly completely closed. The osseous structures of the right carpal joint are within normal limits. No abnormalities of the soft tissue structures surrounding the left carpal joint are appreciated.

SEX

Neutered Male

The left radius presents a curved axis.

AGE

8 Months

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Curved conformation axis of the left radius
- Normal left carpal joint

The radiographic study of the left carpal joint presents without specific abnormalities. Rule out relevant angular limb deformity of the axis of the left radius & ulna (e.g. such as short ulna syndrome) ± incongruity of the left elbow joint as source for the persistent front limb lameness – well-positioned radiographs including the entire antebrachium and elbow joints in two orthogonal imaging planes compared to the contralateral limb would be beneficial.
