



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Nana Bermudez
Monroig Patient presented for dental cleaning procedure. Patient has been doing well at home, no vomiting or diarrhea. In previous bloodwork patient has not had elevations in liver enzymes. Patient is up to date in vaccination and flea and tick prevention. Patient is not PU/PD or polyphagic. Patient is indoor/outdoor. Patient presented in fasting.

SPECIES Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Mild increase in liver size and rounded liver margins upon abdominal palpation. CBC: WNL CHEM: ALP >2000. ALT 128.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX & ABDOMEN

BREED

A right lateral view of the thorax and radiographs of the abdomen in three imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Thorax

SEX

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

Female Spayed

The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

AGE

The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

10 Years

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

INTERPRETED BY

The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected.

The cranioventral aspect of the lung field is partially overexposed.

The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

HOSPITAL NAME

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

Abdomen

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

REFERRING VET

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

INVOICE

The caudoventral hepatic margins are mildly rounded and the liver is extending caudally beyond the pylorus of the stomach. The gastric axis is paralleling the ribs, as expected.

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape and opacity.

DATE

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

Monroig The stomach is in its anticipated position and presents normal content.
The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.

SPECIES

The colon is seen in the expected position and presents with appropriate content.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Mild hepatomegaly
- Structural normal thorax

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Potentials for the mild hepatomegaly include metabolic hepatic disease/steroid induced hepatopathy, hepatitis or less likely neoplastic infiltration. Ultrasound including FNA sampling can be used as minimally advanced diagnostic tests.

Female Spayed The radiographic study presents without signs of abdominal masses.
