RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

SPECIES Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review.

Canine **RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The body condition score is 7/9.

BREED The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

Pitbull Mix The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

SEX

Spayed Female The cranial mediastinum presents the expected soft tissue opacity. The mediastinal width is less than twice the width of the vertebral column at the same level.

AGE

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

10 Years, 3 Months The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected.

INTERPRETED BY

The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.
