RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE CERVICAL & THORACIC SPINE

Radiographs of the cervical and thoracic spine in a lateral view are provided for review.

BREED

French Bulldog

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The scapula is superimposed on the caudal segment of the cervical spine.

No abnormalities of the cervical spine are appreciated.

T5 to T9 present as hemivertebra.

The remainder of the osseous and soft tissue structures of the thoracic spine are within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Hemivertebra T5 to T9
- Normal cervical spine

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study presents without abnormalities, be aware that evaluation of the caudal cervical spine is limited by the superimposed scapula.

In case of strong suspicion of compressive myelopathy, recommend complementing workup by cross-sectional imaging.
