Robertson History: Dog had a mass on the lower jaw and pathology revealed melanoma, we are looking to see if there is metastasis in the lungs.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

SPECIES
Canine Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

BREED
Miniature Schnauzer The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits. The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

SEX
Male The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

Male The cranial mediastinum presents the expected soft tissue opacity. The mediastinal width is less than twice the width of the vertebral column at the same level.

AGE
8 Years The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

INTERPRETED BY
Sebastian Schaub, DVM Dr. med. vet. DipECVDI The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected. The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.
