P presented on 7/18 for limping. Dr unable to access any lameness at exam. P is FIV +. O states P still limping intermittently since Sunday and now appetite down. Rads taken today of RF elbow (the affected limb) and comparison of LF.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ELBOW JOINTS

Radiographs of both elbow joints in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Both elbow joints present smooth osseous margins. A sesamoid bone of the supinator muscle is noted at the cranioproximal aspect of the radial head bilaterally.
