


**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Ruby Wong Wheezing sounds with breathing, while resting. No shortness of breath, no exercise intolerance. Started about 3-4 days ago. No open mouth breathing. More episodes of reverse sneezing

**SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX**

Canine Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**
**BREED**

The body condition score is 7/9.

Pomeranian

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

**SEX**

The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

Spayed Female

The caudal contour of the cardiac silhouette is steep, and the caudal cardiac waist is lost. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

**AGE**

The cranial mediastinum presents the expected soft tissue opacity. The mediastinal width is less than twice the width of the vertebral column at the same level.

10 Years

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

**INTERPRETED BY**

The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected.

The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity – multiple end-on projections of pulmonary vessels are seen throughout the lung field; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

**HOSPITAL NAME**

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**
**INVOICE**

The appreciated mild left sided cardiomegaly might just be a subjective impression due to the thoracic conformation, especially if not heart murmur is present. If a cardiac murmur is appreciated, mitral valve disease is the top differential.

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No additional abnormalities are appreciated, rule out upper airway disease as source for the described clinical signs.
