



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Willy Bergeron History: Difficulty breathing and swelling of the nose.

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE SKULL

SPECIES

A high resolution pre- and post-contrast CT study of the skull is provided for review.

Feline

COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

BREED

The tooth elements 107 and 308 are absent. The periodontal space of triadan 409 is moderately widened and the respective tooth presents evidence of resorptive lesions.

Manx

SEX

A generalized significant soft tissue swelling of the rostrodorosal aspect of the nose/nasal planum is appreciated, involving the alar fold bilaterally; the soft tissue swelling is uniform soft tissue attenuating and contrast enhancing. The nares bilaterally are markedly narrowed due to the swelling. The nasal cavity presents the expected aerated spaces between thin & even conchae and turbinates with smooth mucosal lining.

Neutered Male

AGE

Both temporomandibular joints present congruent joint spaces with even subchondral bone surfaces and are considered within normal limits.

12 Years

The left tympanic bulla contains a small amount of fluid attenuating material, the bony wall is smooth and thin. The external ear canals are within normal limits.

INTERPRETED BY

The brain presents no deviation from normal anatomy and symmetry. The brain parenchyma is homogeneous and within normal limits for attenuation and distribution of contrast enhancement. The ventricular system is non-dilated and symmetric.

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The mandibular lymph nodes bilaterally are moderately enlarged, rounded, uniform soft tissue attenuating & contrast enhancing.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The diffuse swelling of the nasal planum can be caused by diffuse neoplastic infiltration (e.g. squamous cell carcinoma, round cell tumor) or inflammatory reaction (e.g. insect bite). The enlarged mandibular lymph nodes are equivocal for metastatic spread versus reactive hyperplasia. Further
