



**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Padme Amidala Negro Ocasio During PE on 6/22/2023 a heart murmur was auscultated, and VHS measurement was high. P cough occasionally, is very anxious and is very active.

**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX**

**SPECIES** Radiographs of the thorax in two imaging planes are provided for review.

Canine **RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

**BREED** The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

Beagle The heart is of mildly prominent, the vertebral heart score is 11.3. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

**SEX** The cranial mediastinum presents the expected soft tissue opacity. The mediastinal width is less than twice the width of the vertebral column at the same level.

Female The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

**AGE** The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected.

4 Years The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

**INTERPRETED BY**

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

- Generalized mild cardiomegaly

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The mild cardiomegaly can still present normal anatomy and might be accentuated if radiograph has been taken during end-diastole – I consider this most likely here. However, as a cardiac murmur is appreciated in the clinical examination recommend complementing workup by a cardiac echo to confirm normal cardiac chamber size and function and further workup of the heart murmur.
