PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Patient presented for: 2 days ago O noticed PT limping, was weight bearing but PT still played and moving around on it. Yesterday PT started to limp worse and became non weight bearing I am concerned that P is minimally to non-weight bearing in the left forelimb. At this time, I do not see any obvious cause for his presentation and I recommend that we send the radiographs out for evaluation by a radiologist to determine underlying cause.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE FRONT LIMBS

A complete set of radiographs of the front paws is provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous and soft tissue structures of the front paws are within normal limits.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Normal front paws

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the front paws is negative for pathology. The proximal aspects of the front limbs present without overt abnormalities.

Consider a clinical trial with rest and NSAID and reevaluating the patient if clinical signs are refractory to therapy.
