Gizmo Sadilek Hyporexia and vomiting started 8/9. Vomiting resolved after supportive care. But still nauseous and hyporexic.  
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Senior panel NSF on 8/10.

**SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN**

Feline Radiographs of the abdomen in three imaging planes are provided for review.

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

**BREED** The intervertebral disc space L5/L6 is narrowed and the respective vertebral endplates present mild spondylosis formation.  
DSH

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

**SEX** The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

MN The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity.

**AGE** Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

**INTERPRETED BY** The stomach is in its anticipated position and is empty.

The colon is seen in the expected position and presents with appropriate content.
