Pepper Bennett On 7/10 Pepper fractured her left radioulnar, had her in a splint for three weeks and switched to a soft bandage on 7/31. After 1 week, we removed the bandage because she is doing well and is weight bearing. We're rechecking the healing process of the fracture since she has been out of the splint bandages.

SPECIES

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Pepper is doing well and is weight bearing on the leg. Owner said she still limps every once in a while.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE LEFT ANTEBRACHIUM

BREED

Radiographs of the left antebrachium in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The fracture lines in the mid diaphysis of the radius and ulna are completely filled with trabecular bone and progressive smoothing of the callus formation at the same level is appreciated.

SEX

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Chronic traumatic mid diaphyseal transverse fracture left radius & ulna with progressive fracture healing – the fracture is in the transition of the reparation to the remodeling phase

AGE

5 Months

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The fracture of the left antebrachium is in the last stage of fracture healing and considered to be stable.
