PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS History: intermittent limping on right rear leg it is worst after he wake up in the morning per owner rimadyl tablet didn't help his limping

SPECIES Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: cranial drawer neg didnt feel any patellar luxation no pain or crepitus on palpating the right hindleg

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT STIFLE JOINT

BREED Radiographs of the right stifle joint in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

Golden Retriever/Miniature Poodle

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The right stifle joint presents smooth osseous margins. The patella of the right stifle joint is in situ. A mild intracapsular swelling of the right stifle joint is appreciated, the infrapatellar fat pad presents mild soft tissue striation.

SEX

Spayed Female

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Mild articular swelling right stifle joint

AGE INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

1 Years

The radiographic study of the right stifle joint presents signs of mild joint effusion – can be traumatic, degenerative or primary inflammatory in origin. The most common cause for effusion of the stifle joint is pathology of the cranial cruciate ligament ± meniscal disease. If there is suspicion for underlying arthritis, recommend a synovial tap.
