



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Luca Grasso History: P presents for hunched position with tail between his leg. O reports started a few days ago. P is also lethargic. BM's are very small and hard. No change in diet. P will go up and down stairs but seems hesitant to do so.

SPECIES RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Canine Radiographs of the abdomen in three imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Yorkie The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

SEX

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

Neutered Male

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

AGE

3 Years

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape and opacity.

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach is in its anticipated position and contains a small amount of gas and ingesta.

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and generalized mildly distended by gas.
