**PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

on-going lameness in the front left leg, and now right presenting lameness. Been on and off 8-9 months, has been good, will get an "episode" after running around, O will massage shoulder and be okay. Last one happened about - 2 months ago. Right thoracic limb lameness; suspect elbow dysplasia; fragmented medial coronoid, etc.

**COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHY OF THE FRONT LIMBS**

A plain CT study of the front limbs in a bone and soft tissue reconstruction is provided for review.

**BREED**

Great Dane

**COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The vertebral endplates C5/C6 present mild spondylosis formation.

The periarticular bones of the right shoulder joint present mild osteophyte new bone formation, R>L. The right humeral head presents a shallow, irregular crescent shaped defect of the subchondral bone in the caudal aspect, measuring 10 x 10 mm in size.

**SEX**

The left shoulder joint presents very mild osteophyte new bone formation, no abnormalities of the surrounding soft tissue structures are appreciated.

**AGE**

4 Years, 1 Month

Both elbow joints present smooth osseous margins and a congruent joint space. The medial coronoid process of both elbow joints is well defined and has a homogeneous density.

**COMPUTED TOMOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS**

- Osteochondrosis dissecans (OCD) lesion right shoulder joint
- Mild degenerative osteoarthritis right shoulder joint
- Very mild degenerative osteoarthritis left shoulder joint
- Spondylosis deformans C5/C6
- Normal elbow joints bilaterally

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The OCD lesion of the right shoulder joint is a potential source for the right front limb lameness. The remainder of the osseous and soft tissue structures of the right front limb present without abnormalities.

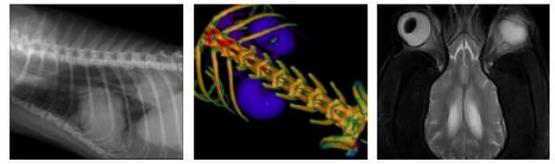

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
