



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Blythe McFall
 Patient presented for a limp on her left hind leg. Initially was non weight bearing but will now toe touch some. She was started on tramadol which did help. Owner did report that her appetite as been decreased and she is down in weight. Bloodwork showed a positive results for anaplasmosis and treatment with doxycycline has been started. The rest of the bloodwork and UA were all within normal limits except for a few mild electrolyte changes. Radiographs performed at the appointment showed a prominent fat pad on the left stifle, moth eaten caudal wings of pelvis and right cranial wing. Spondylosis was also noted at T13-L1. R/O: complete ACL rupture left stifle R/O: Multiple myeloma, osteosarcoma, other neoplasia, organ disease

Goldendoodle RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS

Radiographs of the pelvis in two orthogonal imaging planes are provided for review.

SEX RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Spayed Female
 The VD view of the pelvis is moderately rotated.

The osseous structures of the pelvis are within normal limits. Both coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and congruent joint spaces.

AGE
 10 Years
 The volume of the left thigh musculature is moderately decreased.

- Disuse atrophy left hind limb

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

HOSPITAL NAME
 Faith Animal Care
 The radiographic study of the pelvis presents without abnormalities, but the atrophy of the left thigh musculature. Rule out lameness originating from the distal aspects of the left hind limb (e.g. stifle joint, tarsal joint) or underlying neurological disease (e.g. IVDD, neuritis, neoplasia).

The heterogeneity of the left sacral wing is considered as a sequel to the superimposed gas and feces filled colon.
