8/17/22 HERE FOR LIMPING, RECHECKING TODAY  
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Exam Notes: BARH. Weightbearing lameness occasionally toe-touching left pelvic limb. Left stifle--thickened, medial buttress, no effusion palpated today and unable to get patella to luxate today. Painful on stifle extension. Decreased muscle mass compared to right pelvic limb. Right stifle--no effusion; grade 2/4 MPL, non-painful on orthopedic exam  
Diagnostics & Testing: Radiographs left stifle--consult pending; in-house review shows osteophyte formation and subjectively abnormal tibial plateau angle--no to minimal effusion? Pending radiology review
