



**PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Major Landry  
 Off and on lameness that usually occurs after running on the beach. P starts limping on left rear leg and seems lethargic for a few days. There is a small white spot on the rostral muzzle that seems to appear whenever this occurs. O was told by previous vet that autoimmune disease could be related, specifically mentioned Lupus.

**SPECIES**

 Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: No obvious lameness during today's exam Is somewhat dropped in the rear but no more than often seen in GSDs Normal stifle ROM, no cranial drawer or tibial thrust noted awake or sedated. No crepitus or popping in any of the joints. P did flinch once when attempting cranial drawer but not repeatable. CBC wnl Chem (pre-surg) wnl Small 2 mm round white spot rostral muzzle that O is concerned is Lupus

**BREED RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE PELVIS AND STIFLE JOINTS**

German Shepherd  
 A complete set of radiographs of the pelvis and stifle joints is provided for review.

**SEX RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

NM  
 The osseous and surrounding soft tissue structures of the pelvis are within normal limits. Both coxofemoral joints present smooth osseous margins and congruent joint spaces.

**AGE**  
 The stifle joints present smooth osseous margins and without evidence of intracapsular soft tissue swelling.
