PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Binx is a neutered male oriental shorthair cat with a history of labored breathing since this morning. Appetit and drinking are find and no history of vomiting and diarrhea. On the exam Binx was BAR, HP, chest clear, no heart murmur, respiratory rate:50 BPM, noticed labored breathing and Temp: 40.8 C.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

Radiographs of the thorax in three imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED

Oriental Shorthair

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

SEX

Neutered Male

The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

AGE

4 Years

The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected.

The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the thorax presents without abnormalities. Rule out emerging systemic infectious disease and the labored breathing being a sequela to fever. As radiographic changes of the lung parenchyma can lack behind clinical signs, early stages of pneumonia might be missed; in case of strong suspicion for developing pneumonia/bronchopneumonia follow up radiographs in 2-4 days are recommended.
