PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: Three weeks ago lethargic and stiff on both back limbs, Reluctant to jump into the car or climbing the stairs. Seems painful when he is trying to bend his neck to eat. Hunched back most of the time. Still e/d well. No CVSD. Normal urination.

SPECIES

Canine

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Pain on palpating the lower lumbar area. Tense abdomen. Delayed proprioception of both hindlimbs. Blood work 3 weeks ago: Chemistry: Mild decrease in glucose 2.8, Potassium: 6. Na: K ratio: 25 Mild hypercalcemia and hyperphosphatemia

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

SEX

Neutered Male

The growth plates are age related open.

No abnormalities of the subchondral bone of the vertebral endplates along the cervical, thoracic and lumbar spine are appreciated. The surrounding soft tissue structures are within normal limits.

AGE

10 Months

The pelvis is within normal limits. The coxofemoral joints present with congruent joint spaces and smoothly marginated periarticular bones.

- Normal cervical, thoracic and lumbar spine
- Normal pelvis and coxofemoral joints

The radiographic study of the complete spine and pelvis presents no abnormalities. Although early stages of discospondylitis can be missed by radiography. If there is strong clinical suspicion for discopathy cross-sectional imaging is recommended.
