



PATIENT PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Patient: Peanut Knight
Species: Canine
History: Lacey noticed a few days ago Peanut yelped while chewing a bone laying down. She didn't think anything of it until he yelped again and when she tried to see what was going on noticed a bump on his right front paw that seemed sore when touched. He has been licking at it and the underside of it. She thought maybe he got poked by a cactus. Otherwise he seems normal - eating, drinking and acting fine. Runs around the pasture with his housemates just fine. Lacey also mentioned he is like a garbage can and eats everything and she was also wondering if he may have eaten something but no vomiting or diarrhea.

Breed: Heeler Mix
Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: NORMAL GAIT BEFORE EXAM, RIGHT FRONT LAME (2/4) AFTER EXAM / MANIPULATION. 5MM NODULE ON SKIN OVER DISTAL CARPUS/PROXIMAL MCARPAL PAIN ON MANIPULATION OF BOTH CARPUS AND METACARPALS. NO SWELLING APPRECIATED. Ambulatory X 4. Neck, spine, and tail are normal. No loss of proprioception.

SEX RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT CARPAL JOINTS

Sex: Neutered Male
Study: A complete set of radiographs of the right carpal joint is provide for review.

AGE RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

Age: 9 Months
Findings: The periarticular bones of the right carpal joint present smooth osseous margins. The surrounding soft tissue structures are unremarkable but a mild convex bulge of the cutaneous surface dorsal to the proximal third of the metacarpal bones.

Diagnosis:

- Mild focal swelling dorsal metacarpal bones
- Normal right carpal joint

HOSPITAL NAME INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

Hospital Name: Elizabeth AH
Interpretation: The focal cutaneous swelling dorsal at the metacarpal region is not specific and underlying inflammatory reaction (e.g. insect bite?, foreign body) can be considered. FNA sampling can be used as an advanced diagnostic test.
