Three radiographs of the neck are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The osseous structures of the neck are within normal limits.

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

In the lateral views, the external part of one ear is superimposing with the pharynx & larynx.

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The radiographic study of the neck presents without abnormalities. The roundish heterogeneous opacity superimposed on the laryngeal region is caused by tilting of the head with the external parts of one ear superimposing on the laryngeal region.
