A high resolution plain CT study of the viscerocranium is provided for review.

The tooth elements 108&208 are absent. A very mild horizontal bone loss is seen in the lower jaw quadrants

- Generalized mild horizontal bone loss in the lower jaw quadrants

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

There is no evidence of periodontal abscess formation or clinically significant periodontal disease but evidence of generalized mild horizontal bone loss in all jaw quadrants. A complete dental workup was already performed.
