PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

History: Slowing down. Doesn't want to run any more. Has been coughing and gagging a lot the last two weeks.

SPECIES

Canine

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: Last labwork WNL (4/21). Infiltrative lipoma LH

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX

A complete set of radiographs of the thorax is provided for review.

BREED

Wolf Hound Mix

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

At the caudal aspect of the shoulder joints mild osteophyte new bone formation is visible.

SEX

Neutered Male

The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

AGE

9 Years

The cranial mediastinum presents the expected soft tissue opacity. The mediastinal width is less than twice the width of the vertebral column at the same level.

The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected. The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.
