PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Urinating outside litter box and possible hematuria noted. No PU/PD or stranguria noted. E/D/D fine and no V/D/C/S. BAR, active and no lethargy noted.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: WBC 5.6 with mild neutropenia, P 7.0, USG >1.060. pH 5.5, 3+ proteinuria, 3+ hematuria, 2-5 WBC, 50-75 RBC, 2+ epi cells, no crystalluria, no bacteruria, all else WNL.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ABDOMEN

Radiographs of the abdomen in three imaging planes are provided for review.

BREED

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

The surrounding bony structures are within normal limits.

SEX

Female Spayed

No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

AGE

1 Year

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity.

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach is in its anticipated position and presents normal content.

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.
