Jake Scheiper History: Decreasing weight over 6 months - was 65 pounds 6/2020, now 40 lbs. Appetite notably decreased over 24 hours. 2-3/6 heart murmur.

Canine **RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE THORAX AND ABDOMEN**

A complete set of radiographs of the thorax and abdomen is provided for review.

BREED **RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

German Shorthaired

Thorax

SEX One of the pictured elbow joints presents moderate to marked osteophyte new bone formation and the contralateral elbow joint presents evidence of mild osteophyte new bone formation.

Male The extrathoracic soft tissues present homogeneous without abnormalities.

AGE The heart is of normal size and shape, there is no evidence of cardiac chamber or vascular enlargement. The pulmonary vasculature is within normal limits.

14 Years The cranial mediastinum presents the expected soft tissue opacity. The mediastinal width is less than twice the width of the vertebral column at the same level.

INTERPRETED BY The trachea is normal in diameter and presents the anticipated course. The luminal outline of the trachea is smooth.

The bronchial tree presents with thin walls and tapers uniformly towards the periphery as expected. The lung parenchyma presents the expected architecture and opacity; the intrapulmonary vascular branching is seen up to the third order lung vessels.

HOSPITAL NAME The diaphragm is well delineated with even surface and the expected mild cranial bulging of the diaphragmatic cupola.

INVOICE No abnormalities of the extraabdominal soft tissues are noted. The abdominal wall is smooth and thin.

The serosal detail is maintained throughout the peritoneal and retroperitoneal space.

The liver is appropriate in position, size and presents uniform opacity.

The splenic head is in the anticipated position and within normal limits for size and opacity. The splenic body and tail are considered normal for position, size, shape and opacity.

SPECIES

Canine

Both kidneys are seen and present with normal size, shape, delineation and opacity. The urinary bladder is in its anticipated position. No radiopaque calculi are noted throughout the upper and lower urinary tract.

The stomach is in its anticipated position and presents normal content.

The small intestinal loops are of even diameter and non-dilated, a small amount of gas is seen within the small intestinal loops and considered within normal limits.

The colon is seen in the expected position and presents with appropriate content.

- Degenerative osteoarthritis elbow joints bilaterally
- Structural normal thorax
- Structural normal abdomen

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

The current radiographic study of the thorax and abdomen presents no specific abnormalities, explaining the described clinical signs. The results of blood work are pending, complementing workup by an abdominal ultrasound examination might be beneficial as well to check for structural changes of the parenchymal organs.
