The left shoulder joint presents smooth osseous margins, no abnormalities of the surrounding soft tissue structures are appreciated.

The radiographic study of the left shoulder joint presents without abnormalities. In case of strong clinical suspicion for pathology of the bicipital tendon or rotator cuff injury, recommend complementing workup by an ultrasound examination of the shoulder joint.
