PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS

Patient fell/jumped off couch 4 days prior. Per owner patient has been whining & limping, on/off lameness on right front. Patient is otherwise acting normally.

Abnormal PE/Chem/CBC/UA Results: No pain elicited on exam. Clicking on manipulation of right elbow.

RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE ELBOW JOINTS

Radiographs of both elbow joints in two imaging planes are provided for review.

RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS

At the proximal aspect of the anconeal process of the right elbow joint, a double contour of the osseous margin is appreciated. Otherwise, both elbow joints present smooth osseous margins and no abnormalities of the surrounding soft tissue structures.

RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS

- Very mild osteophyte formation right elbow joint
- Normal left elbow joint

INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

There is evidence of very mild degenerative joint disease of the right elbow joint and acute insult on mild degenerative joint disease might be a source for lameness. There is no evidence of fracture or overt soft tissue swelling.

Consider a clinical trial with NSAID and rest and reevaluating the patient if clinical signs persist.
