**PRESENTING CLINICAL SIGNS**

Patient presented for limping on the right forelimb. This patient had a previous history of limping Sept 3rd 2020 was sent home with Gabapentin and Rimadyl and did well. Pt was tentatively diagnosed with HOD.

**SPECIES**

Canine

**RADIOGRAPHIC STUDY OF THE RIGHT SHOULDER JOINT**

A complete set of radiographs of the right shoulder joint is provided for review.

**BREED**

Goldendoodle

**RADIOGRAPHIC FINDINGS**

The subchondral bone of the right humeral head presents a crescent shaped mild irregular defect, measuring approximately 1.7 cm in width and surrounding mild sclerosis. A thin mineralized lamella is covering the defect of the right humeral head.

**SEX**

Male Neuter

The left shoulder joint presents without overt changes but is not in the central beam.

**RADIOGRAPHIC DIAGNOSIS**

- Osteochondrosis dissecans (OCD) right humeral head

**AGE**

21 Months

**INTERPRETATION OF THE FINDINGS & FURTHER RECOMMENDATIONS**

The findings are consistent with an OCD lesion of the right humeral head. Arthroscopy or arthrotomy is recommended to revise the defect and remove potential loose cartilaginous material.

Recommend radiographs centered on the left shoulder joint to rule in/out OCD of the left shoulder joint as it can occur bilaterally.
